ELECTION TO THE MANAGING COMMITTEE FOR YEAR 2017-18 to 2018-19

In pursuance of Clause 19 (1) (a) of the Cost Accountant's Chapter Bye-laws 2013 as amended in 2017 of the Institute of Cost Accountants of India, the Managing Committee of the Chapter notifies the following :

1. Vide provisions of Clause 19 (1) (a) election to the Managing Committee shall be held as per Schedule shown in Item No 4 of this notification.
2. 5. Nomination Forms :

Nomination Forms for Nomination to Managing Committee of the Chapter for the year 2017-18 to 2018-19 shall be available from Chapter Office from 16.09.2017. The duly filled in forms shall be submitted by hand delivery by the candidate as per the provisions of clause 19 and all other relevant provisions of Chapter Bye-laws 2013 as amended in 2017.

6. Fees for Election :

(1) A candidate for Nomination to Managing Committee shall pay a nomination fees as mentioned below :

- a. Member of the Institute : Rs. 1,000/- irrespective of the number of nominations
- b. Student of the Institute : Rs. 500 / irrespective of the number of nominations

(2) Fees shall be paid by a demand draft drawn in favour of "The Institute of Cost Accountants of India Aurangabad Chapter", payable at Aurangabad.

Note: A candidate whose nomination is held to be invalid shall be entitled to receive refund of fifty percent of the fees payable.

7. Appeal and Election Code of Conduct :

Appeals and Election Code of Conduct.- With a view to maintain a healthy and peaceful atmosphere during the election process for ensuring a free and fair election, the Election Officer, shall receive the appeals and complaints with regard to election and forward it by Speed Post to the Secretary of the Institute or in the absence of the Secretary, to any such officer as designated in this behalf by the Council within 3 days of receipt of the appeal or complaint for disposal. The decision of the Secretary of the Institute or in the absence of the Secretary, any such officer as designated in this behalf by the Council, shall be final in this regard. The time limit for filing appeal or complaint on any matter relating to the conduct of election shall be 7 days from the date of occurrence of an incident pertaining to the election.
